LOPEN VILLAGE FUND - UPDATE



Further to funds raised for village projects in 2019, a Village Fund has been set up to manage money raised and provide funds for Village projects, using the monies raised at the various events, social activities and donations made to the Village. This is distinct from any Church specific funds, and are to be used to benefit the wider Village.

The fund administrators will be Ed Moore, Michael Armstrong and Sue Champion, with Chris Marsh representing the Lopen Parish Council.

A Fund Charter and the process for applying for funds will be published in due course.

The type of projects supported will be anything deemed to benefit the Village, and it will also provide a centralised repository for larger plans like the purchase or rental of a field and a hall as a Village Community space in the long term. The contacts regarding the Fund are:

ANCESTRAL VISIT TO THE CROWN INN

We were contacted in July by a Nicholas French:

I am in the process of producing a fairly detailed biography of my life so that future generations of my family will have a definitive record. My best estimate so far of my time living at The Crown Inn, Church Street, Lopen, was that it was for a period in 1955 when I was aged 3. As I understand, my grandfather, Frank Pearce was the licensee in 1955 and he died in 1956 whilst still in residence there. I had a great aunt, Mrs Elsie Denman, nee Lamb, who at the time lived in the house immediately before you reach the church and on the same side of the road as the church.

Nicholas and his wife, Elaine, subsequently visited Lopen and met with Patrick & Carolyn, who currently live in the property, and also visited the church and the house his great aunt lived in.
