

LOPEN PARISH COUNCIL

Parish Council Elections - Get Involved!

This is the last Eye before the deadline for Parish Council - Councillor nominations for the Parish elections taking place on 7th May 2015 (combined with the UK Parliament and South Somerset District Council elections).

Lopen PC Clerk Kim McDonald (contact details on the back page) has the necessary candidate nomination form bundles which are now available on request. Some forms require input from other parties (i.e. proposer and seconder) so please leave sufficient time to complete and **hand deliver** to SSDC Brympton Way Yeovil no later than 4pm Thursday 9th April.

Earlier this year we were successful in our application to increase the size of our Council and this is the first election where seven Councillor vacancies exist (was five).

Please give some serious thought to standing as a Lopen Parish Council candidate in this election. It would greatly benefit the whole community to have as diverse a range of applicants as possible. On our scale of activity, this is not a particularly onerous undertaking and, under normal circumstances, only requires a few hours of your time each month. I will gladly take the time to talk through the role with any prospective candidate – please make contact with me (contact details on the back page- Barry Davolls) if you would like a chat.

Road Works

A road closure will be in place on part of Broomhill Lane (AKA Lopen Lane) from 11th to 29th May and in Snap Ant from 1st to 26th June. This is required to replace the existing water main in this area which has reached the end of it's life and suffers near constant leakage.

The Snap Ant closure has the potential to cause some difficulties for us all but as we have not yet been given the full details, it may not turn out to be as challenging as this simple message suggests.

LOPEN PARISH COUNCIL'S TRAINING FOR MEDICAL EMERGENCIES, CPR AND USE OF THE VILLAGE DEFIBRILLATOR

The first session took place on 20th March.

accessible at all times in the Church porch. We are very
fortunate to have such a highly qualified instructor in
Sarah who gave us an excellent lesson on training for
emergencies as well as in the use of the defibrillator.
Sarah has generously offered to do the same for all other
villagers who would like to undergo the training."

Added Joan...

"There is no excuse for not taking this free training and possibly saving a life. As our son did when, while working as park ranger, he came across a young couple in desperate straits as their toddler had stopped breathing. He applied CPR and the child is now a healthy teenager."

April dates will be advised on the village noticeboard and on the village website. All sessions will be in the Schoolroom, courtesy of the PPC.

12 month subscription is £48. At less than a pound per week, this service remains good value and offers a quick and easy way for your garden waste to be collected and composted.

24 month subscription is £91. We are continuing with a 2 year option as it has been popular. We are able to offer a discount as we save money by reducing our admin and postage costs. In addition, 24 month subscribers will be protected from any possible price increase in 2016/17.

As an alternative to bins you can purchase garden sacks from us which currently cost £25 for 10 sacks. These will be collected fortnightly and can be more suitable for smaller gardens or those with access issues.
