Scams / Local Numbers!

We are hearing several reports of members receiving scam calls from local numbers. These are where scammers are trying to trick you into

believing they MUST be real as they are nearby. Do please remain alert to any calls you receive - for instance: advising you have a slow broadband connection, your loft insulation does not meet current regulations, you have a delivery from Royal Mail that has not been fully paid, your Amazon Prime has expired or has been hacked, etc. These will almost certainly be scams - *if in doubt hang up!* Let the phone line clear for at least 5 minutes and then call the company back on a number you know, preferably on a different phone.

And never press 1 on your keypad if asked!
